Note 1 - External Audit Fees.

Under £10k income/expenditure is now exempt from external audit fees. If any grants are obtained in 2014-2015, external audit fees would be £100 for income/expenditure between £10,001-£25,000 and £200 for income/expenditure between £25,001 - £50,000. The grant application to GET (under £25,000) should therefore be taken into account in case this application is successful.

Extra fees may, however, be charged in any event for additional work, such as where the annual report is not completed properly or where auditors consider an objection to the accounts from a local elector. This work will be charged at between £85 per hour and (where the most senior grade of staff deals with the issue) £325 per hour. An amount can be included in the budget if councillors feel this is appropriate but it is very difficult to budget for an amount for this eventuality.
