HUNDRED CLUB RULES

Registered Charity No: 301598

The name of the Club shall be “Pauntley Village Hall 100 Club” and is a Small Society Lottery.

- The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds for the upkeep and running of Pauntley Village Hall and for its refurbishment.
- Anybody over 18 years can become a member of the 100 Club.
- The subscription to the 100 Club for one number shall be £24 per year payable annually in advance by standing order, BACS payment or cheque. Details of how to pay are provided on the membership application form. This will give members one number, between 1 and 100, which will be placed in each draw. Each member is allocated a permanent number in the monthly draw. This number shall remain with the member provided their subscription is up to date. Members may have and are encouraged to have multiple subscriptions.
- There is no provision to opt in/out on a draw-by-draw basis.
- The normal 100 Club year will be xxx to xxx. Members wishing to leave the 100 Club should do so at the end of the club membership for that year, and refunds will not be given for people wishing to withdraw before the year end.
- There shall be four prize draws per year, to be held in public at Pauntley Village Hall, with each draw having three prizes. The first draw will be held in xxx at xxx, the second draw in xxx, the third draw in xxx and the fourth draw at xxx.
- The prize fund will be 50% of the money collected in subscriptions for that quarter. Prizes will be apportioned as follows: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 15% and 3rd prize of 10% of total quarterly income.
- Winning numbers will be displayed on the Pauntley Village Website www.pauntley.org.uk and will be available on request from the administrators (contact details here). The 100 Club administrators will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes to the winners within a reasonable period after the draw. If a winner cannot be contacted after 6 months, the winnings will be placed in to Pauntley Village Hall funds.
- The Club will be run by the administrators and their decision will be binding on all parties in the event of any dispute.

- The administrators shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
